



French Association for Containment visits Krantz filter system installations at The Pirbright Institute in Great Britain

Last year Krantz delivered all HEPA - filter systems for the new buildings (DP 1 project) at The Pirbright Institute, largest facility for research on animal diseases in Great Britain. During last month site acceptance tests and commissioning have been taking place.

The French Association for Containment (L'ASSOCIATION FRANÇAISE DU CONFINEMENT) was organizing a visit on October 10th, where interested expert audience could get information regarding the institute generally and the Krantz filter systems especially.

After an introduction into the building project by David Crampton, Construction Director at the general contractor Shepherd Construction Ltd., the participants could convince themselves during the visit through the impressive laboratory building of the quality and functionality of the installations. At the installed HEPA - filter systems qualifications like tightness tests, efficiency measurement and fumigation were demonstrated.
